**WORKSHOP ON EFFECTIVE PARTNERSHIP ENGAGEMENTS cum PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW**

TO: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The DepEd XII is committed to sustain and scale up innovations and productivity in schools through partnership. The quarterly reports on Adopt-a-School Program (ASP) through the School Partnership Data Sheets (SPDS) revealed that there only a few partners actively engaged in schools in Region 12 that resulted to uneven or unproportioned distribution of delivery of external supports.
