Regional Roll-out Expansion Training on Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy (ELLN)

To: **All Schools Division Superintendents**
This Region

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Programs and Projects, there will be another round of Regional Roll-out Expansion Training on Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy (ELLN) to be conducted on December 3-12, 2017. The venue shall be announced later through an advisory.

2. The participants for this training are the school head and one K to 3 teacher of schools which were not included in the first stage of implementation but are situated in the districts previously identified. Below is the distribution of the number of schools of the identified divisions:

3. The participants are expected to be at the venue before 8:00 in the morning of December 3, 2017. Breakfast will be served on Dec. 3 and the last meal will be dinner of December 12, 2017. They are also expected to bring a laptop, an extension cord, and Curriculum Guides and Teacher's Guides in Filipino, English, Math, Kindergarten and MTB-MLE.

4. No proxy shall be allowed for school heads and they should make sure that classes of their teachers who will attend this training are taken over by other teachers.

5. Division ELLN focal persons are advised to fill-out the attached template for the mapping of the actual participants to this training to be submitted on or before October 20, 2017 through yogmagno@yahoo.com.ph.

6. Food, accommodation and training resource materials shall be charged to OSEC Funds while travelling expenses are chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Criteria for Selecting Participants from the Priority Schools

1. A K – 3 mentor must be selected from among the K – 3 teachers of the school using the criteria below. The K – 3 teacher mentor must:
 - 1.1 Be a master teacher (or any equivalent)
 - 1.2 Be recommended by the school head, co-teachers and/or district supervisor as having the potential to facilitate LAC sessions and support fellow K – 3 teachers
 - 1.3 Has experience as a trainer or facilitator
 - 1.4 Has attended previous DepEd training programs related to beginning reading and/or early numeracy or mathematics, such as the K to 12 mass training for Grades 1, 2 or 3 or the National English Proficiency Program
 - 1.5 Has participated in other courses/seminars/workshops/conferences on early literacy, beginning reading, early numeracy and mathematics conducted in partnership with higher education institutions (i.e. UP, PNU, etc.), NGOs and other teacher training providers.
 - 1.6 Has served as chairperson or advocate of school and/or community-based activities related to early literacy and numeracy
 - 1.7 Appreciates and places high value on cultural diversity and multilingualism
 - 1.8 Be computer literate
 - 1.9 Loves teaching young learners and enjoy literature written for children
 - 1.10 Has a good command of English and Filipino
